**Re: SB 350 (De León) – Position Change to NEUTRAL**

Dear Pro Tem de León:

The California Business Roundtable has formally removed our opposition to SB 350 and officially is NEUTRAL on the bill.

Energy is one of the most critically important issues to a strong and vibrant economy. The statewide business community is leading the way in achieving the emission reductions under the current AB 32 regulations and dozens of companion measures such as the renewable portfolio standard and energy efficiency programs.

Our commitment is to achieve the emission reductions at the lowest possible cost to California consumers and businesses. We want California to send a message in the upcoming Paris negotiations that California is committed to policies that can achieve emission reductions while maintaining a strong economy. That is the only way we will ultimately be successful in bringing other states and nations along to solve this problem.
